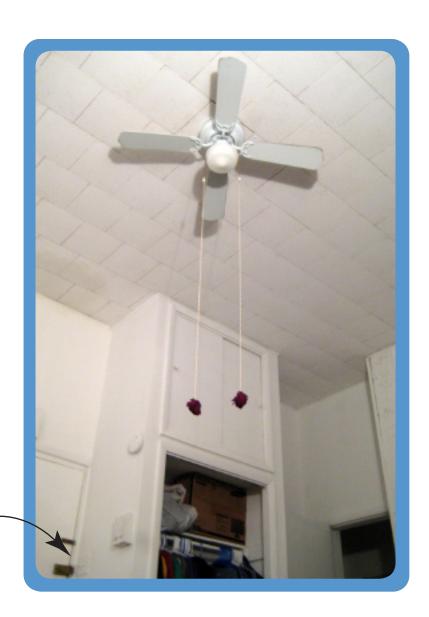
## **Ceiling Fan Control Redesign**

## **Current Problems**

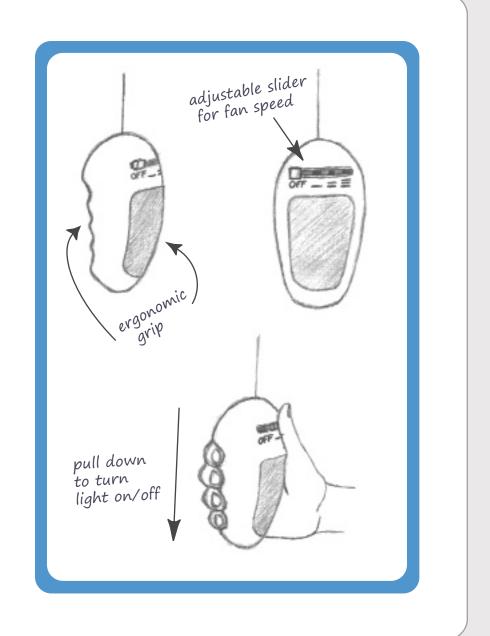
- Not obvious that wall-mounted light switches operate the fan and light, not the pull switches
- After the fan is on, then one of the pull switches can be used to adjust the speed of the fan
- The second pull switch always has no functionality
- No way to distinguish between the two pull switches

Turn on fan and light over here



## **Proposed Solution**

- Simplify the controls into a single pull switch with a thumb slider
- Ergonomic grips afford holding the pull switch – pulling down on the pull switch turns the light on and off
- Adjusting the slider changes the fan

 Location of slider allows for easy adjusting of fan speed with thumb
