



One user said they disliked it.


WINDOW ON A SISTER CITY



Ambient city noise draws a family's attention to the parklet off Walnut Street. The city noise is atypical for Shadyside on a Sunday morning.



They look down the alley and notice other people watching a screen mounted on one of the alley's brick walls.



The screen provides a realtime look into another shopping district in Sheffield England. Street noise is also broadcast out. Passersby are blocked out in order to preserve privacy and prevent any malicious activity.

LASER GRID



Rick's wife wants to stop in to Victoria's Secret, prompting Rick to quickly respond that he'll stay outside and wait for her to return.



Rick heads over to some benches nearby, and notices some sort of laser grid on the way. He thinks it could be a fun way to pass the time and tries to maneuver through the grid.



Drat! A small misstep and the laser hits him, triggering an alarm. He goes back to the beginning to reset the lasers, determined to get through this time.

GAZE DETECTION



Eric is walking in between the parking lot and walnut through a local parklet. He's not really paying attention to much.



Something on the wall catches his eye and he notices the shadow of a person who appears to be talking to someone out of view. It's clear it's a project, but he watches for a few seconds.



Then all of a sudden the shadow of the character he was watching turns to him and points right at him.

One user liked it...


INTERACTIVE FLOOR



Paul stands at the edge of the alley and is interested by the new electronic ground display. He sees that it looks like a beach and it reminds him of a fun vacation he went on with his girlfriend a few months ago.



Paul continues to watch and sees that the floor actually changes—he sees waves crashing down in front of him.



Excited and interested by this new display, Paul walks across to see that the floor is in fact interactive and leaves his footsteps in the sand with each step.

AMBIENT SOUND BENCHES



Eric decides to study outside and notices the soothing rainforest sounds playing from the first ambient bench the girls are sitting on.



Eric has been missing his parent's house on the water, so he decides to sit on his favorite "Beach" bench before he starts working.



Not long after, John sits on the neighboring bench while he waits for his girlfriend to finish shopping. The "Summer Night" bench he sits on compliments Eric's "Beach" expereince.

Speed Dating Results

- People liked:

- People felt uncomfortable by Gaze Detection



Therefore... Gaze Detection

- Wanted to try something different
- Not everything needs to be "Disney-fied"
- Didn't want to disturb readers, musicians

Target Audience

- People passing through the space
- People watchers

Needs We're Meeting

- Stimulating people watchers
- Preserving aesthetics of space for regulars

Features

- Shadow figures will track people passing by
- The figures interact with each other
- The interaction can change over time
