

Faucet Handle Bookmarking

Retro-fit your faucet with a **digital bookmark**: record your ideal knob setting. Save water and time.

Just one minute showering uses ~2.4 gallons of water.

Many of us spend this much time turning faucet handles back and forth to get back to settings we had yesterday. They may not be perfect anymore but there's a good chance they're close.

Automatic faucets are probably the future, but for now retro-fitting existing ones can help make hot-cold moments a bit more efficient.

1 Attach

Customizable rotation sensors
(Serrated plastic with magnets used to measure degree of turn.)

Customizable rotation sensors attach to any knob.

(Can be inside knob, connects with wire behind wall & under spout to aerator.)



Aerator can attach to many spout styles with adapters.


(Also available in various finishes.)

2 Record



Red button records a setting. Current temperature & turn gauges show on a wireless external display and LCD on aerator—all triggered on by starting water.

A wireless display lets you turn handles to your last setting quickly.



Arrows shrink then disappear when approximate setting is reached.
